

IPG Awarded AS9100B Certification - October 2007

Indiana Precision Grinding was recently honored with the recognition of becoming AS9100 certified by QMI, North America's leading management systems registrar. IPG earned an impressive 97.7% rating- notches above the industry standard of 91%. AS9100 certification is the gold standard in the aerospace industry and is recognized as the industry benchmark worldwide.
